National research has shown that positive relationships between Littles and their Bigs have a direct and measurable impact on children's lives.

The Big Brothers Big Sisters Youth Outcomes Survey Report found that for youth enrolled in our Community Based mentoring program:

94% maintained or improved in their attitudes towards risky behaviors

88% maintained or improved in parental trust

85% maintained or improved in their educational expectation

83% maintained or improved in social acceptance

A CALL TO MEN OF COLOR

We have children waiting for the opportunity to meet someone like you. Disproportionately the children we serve and those waiting to be matched are African-American and Hispanic Boys. Their parents seek our support, knowing a Big Brother can recognize their son's potential and model positive choices that put him on the path for success in and out of school.

YOU'RE NOT ALONE

Our program team is here to work with you, the child and the family throughout the course of the mentoring relationship. A Match Support specialist oversees every match, providing support, training and guidance to ensure that every match is a success. We offer free agency events and opportunities for engagement with your little.

REQUIREMENTS

Our Littles deserve the best. Bigs must be 21 years of age or older, have a valid driver's license, participate in an interviewing and application process that includes a national background check, take part in training, and be willing to commit to at least one year in the development of the match relationship.
